# **CHALLENGE, CONVERSION and COMFORT**

The six weeks of Lent move us step by step into the Paschal mystery of Jesus Christ's dying and rising. The Paschal Mystery was given to us as a known yet undetermined reality to enter into and to make our own so that the reign of God proclaimed by Jesus and confirmed by his death and resurrection is entrusted to us.

The living out of the paschal mystery is done in different ways during the season of Lent. Some people prefer to follow the traditional practices of fasting, almsgiving, and prayer from Ash Wednesday until Holy Thursday. While these three practices are important and meaningful, some people are more venturesome trusting in God.

The Lenten scripture readings powerfully CHALLENGE us; call us to CONVERSION; and COMFORT us. CHALLENGE is the call to reorder and restructure how we as individuals and as a community live our lives. CONVERSION is accepting the challenge and moving forward to transform our individual selves and our community practices. COMFORT is what is gained by us knowing that the challenge we have accepted and the conversion we are undergoing is bringing us and our community new life.

The members of the Church of St. Matthew are responding to the CHALLENGE to reorder and restructure how things are done. We are no longer a clustered parish but an independent parish. The Board of Trustees, Parish Finance Council, Parish Pastoral Council, Men's Club, Rosary Society, Liturgy Committee, Music Ministry, Community Members, and Staff Members are adjusting what was done in the past so that we flourish in the present and prosper in the future.

With the acceptance of the Challenge, St. Matthew's community is undergoing CONVERSION and moving forward. The celebration of a Sunday morning Mass, the relocation of the tabernacle closer to the Assembly, and the invitation for Servers and Eucharistic Ministers to be in the Sanctuary are but a few of the liturgical changes that are taking place.

On the Third Sunday of Lent (March 18<sup>th</sup>-19<sup>th</sup>) and on the third Sunday of every month you are invited to bring a food donation to the sanctuary at Offertory time. In March, the food donated will be matched by the Minnesota Food Share Drive and given to Neighborhood House. By bringing our food donation with the bread and wine to the sanctuary, we feed people in need as Christ feeds us through word and sacrament.

On the Fifth Sunday of Lent (April 2), the white marble baptismal font restored from the 1968 fire will become the base for the tabernacle with the Holy Oils placed nearby. These outward signs of the Sacraments of Initiation are reminders of our baptismal commitment to share in the paschal mystery of Christ. The sanctuary platforms will be moved and a ramp will be installed to enable easier access into the sanctuary. The baptismal font, now in the chapel, will be moved into the church for our community to celebrate baptisms and welcome newcomers. These adjustments will facilitate the celebration of funeral Masses and enable larger events, like the performance of the Metropolitan Symphony Orchestra, to take place. Changing to LED ceiling bulbs in the church and in the chapel, will improve lighting and reduce our energy consumption and cost.

In our Pastoral Center, worn-out furniture was reupholstered, fuse boxes were replaced, and the efficiency of the boiler was improved. With these improvements clients of St. Mary's Medical Clinic are being served, children in our Faith Formation Program are learning, and People of Praise are providing outreach. Our bulletin, Web, and Facebook pages are being revised to enthusiastically proclaim that the Church of St. Matthew is a visible expression of God's love

The conversion that is taking place through our weekly financial donations and our designated project contributions, our pitching in to lend a hand when needed, and our reaching out to others result in the COMFORT that together we are bringing our community new life.

Easter promises to be a joy filled celebration because Jesus has and the community of St. Matthew is rising to new life through CHALLENGE, CONVERSION and COMFORT.

#### **MUSIC MINISTRY NOTES**

Did you know the hymns we sing are chosen to specifically reinforce message of the readings of that season's or celebrations readings? Even If you don't feel like singing, read the lyrics as the congregation lifts their voices around you. Singing or following along keeps the Liturgy of the Word in your heart and mind even longer to deepen or faith.

#### **SOME PROGRESS:**

Lighting: there is lighting for the tabernacle and statues in one corner of the church and lighting for the reading material display in another corner. Each of these cost about \$100.

Chairs--13 of them--in the conference room: these chairs were very well constructed and were purchased decades ago. The coverings were worn out; the springs were showing and they were a danger. They have been recovered by an upholstery shop on Rice Street. These costs are not in the budget, but we have made these changes and had this work done for safety reasons, as well as reasons of hospitality. Can you help pay for one or more of these? You can put a properly marked envelope in the collection basket [or send it to the parish center]: \$100 per light; \$200 per chair.

We will put more things on our 'wish list.' Watch for ceiling lighting news soon.
