Synod Small Groups will meet right here at Saint Matthew's Parish on the following **Saturdays: October 2, 9, 23, 30; and November 6 & 13** from **9:30 am to 11:30 am** in the **Church**.

- What is a Synod? It is a gathering designed to help a bishop shepherd the local Church.
- By participating in Synod small groups at Saint Matthew's you will:
 - have opportunities for personal spiritual growth;
 - help build fellowship and community among Saint Matthew's parishioners;
 - discover more about the Catholic faith with our church community;
 - contribute to Archbishop Hebda's pastoral plan for the future of the Archdiocese.
- There are six sessions total – one per week over seven weeks. No session October 16 due to church cleaning that day.
- Each session is two hours; half that time is spent in discussion with your group or giving feedback.
- There's no pre-work, and no homework.
- You can come with a group of family or friends, or you can join a new small group with other parishioners.
- Other sessions will be offered for parish groups (Parish and Finance Councils, Liturgy Committee, Rosary Society, Men's Club). Those dates, times and locations will be announced soon.

Everyone is invited to participate during these weeks in October and November.
