ROBERT STREET CONSTRUCTION TIMELINE UPDATE

From the Minnesota Department of Transportation

1. Construction work will now begin this summer. Due to a supply shortage, MnDOT will not be able to begin work as planned. Construction will now happen this summer (exact timing yet to be determined). Thank you for your flexibility, we'll notify you when a construction start date is solidified.
2. The George St./viaduct work will happen first, followed by the Union Pacific Railroad bridge. MnDOT crews will first repair the Robert St. viaduct and overpass bridge, closing the bridge for 6-8 weeks. After that work is complete, MnDOT will repair the bridge over the Union Pacific Railroad tracks, which will also be closed for 6-8 weeks. Detours will be in place during both closures.
