## ANNUAL FIX-IT AND COMMUNITY DINNER

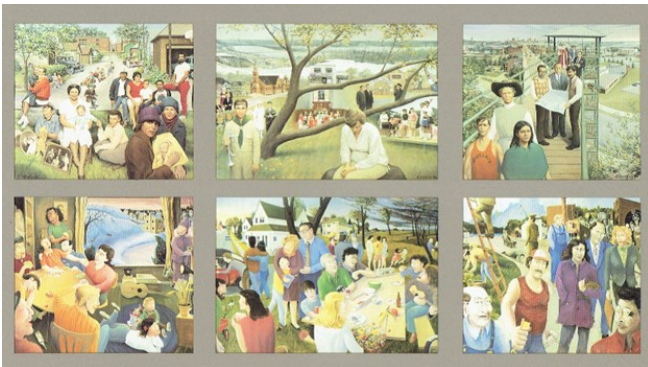
Saturday, September 24, 2022

2:00 PM in the Church

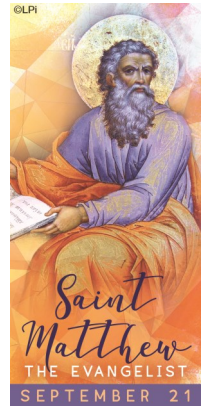
