Weekly Reflection

What is this Labor Day Weekend all about?...

The USCCB says, "The economy must serve people, not the other way around. Work is more than a way to make a living; it is a form of continuing participation in God's creation. If the dignity of work is to be protected, then the basic rights of workers must be respected--the right to productive work, to decent and fair wages, to the organization and joining of unions, to private property, and to economic initiative." USCCB website - The Dignity of Work and the Rights of Workers

The Catholic Worker movement was launched on May 1, 1933, in the depths of the Great Depression, with the distribution of the first issue of the newspaper. Dorothy Day and three others took the 8-page tabloid to Union Square, thronged with communists and others celebrating May Day, and sold it for a penny a copy: the same price it is today. It was addressed "to our readers": For those who are sitting on the park benches in the warm spring sunlight. For those who are huddling in shelters trying to escape the rain. For those who are walking the street in the all but futile search to find work. For those who think that there is no hope for the future, no recognition of their plight, — this little paper is addressed.

It is printed to call their attention to the fact that the Catholic Church has a social program — to let them know that there are men of God who are working not only for their spiritual, but for their material welfare.
